Our denomination's **Office of Social Justice** wishes to highlight the intentional effort of **World Renew** as it responds to famine and extreme food insecurity in many African countries. Every dollar donated by Canadians to World Renew until June 30 will be matched by the government. As this concerns over 20 million people, pray relief efforts will be many and effective.

Tomorrow the bicycling mission **Sea to Sea 2017**, hosted by World Renew and Partner's Worldwide, will begin its 6,750 km ride to help fight world hunger starting in Vancouver, BC. The registered 135 riders have already raised a combined \$1,314,467 out of their \$1,500,000 goal. Our former pastor, Rev. Gary Bomhof, is joining this year's ride ending in Halifax, NS, August 31. Pray for safety, rider health and effective hunger relief.
