

This coming Thursday **Synod 2018** of the Christian Reformed Church in North America will convene on the campus of Calvin College in Grand Rapids, Michigan, until June 14. Hosting will be Pillar Church in Holland, Michigan, which is a “union church” or affiliated with both the CRCNA and the RCA. Delegates from our Classis Huron are **Pastor John Medendorp** (Kitchener) and **Pastor Kevin teBrake** (Exeter). They will be joined by **Elder Rick DeGraaf** and **Deacon James Vanderleeuw**. Pray for safety in travel, Spirit-led conversations and decisions including mutual encouragement through fellowship and worship. Synod will be engaging ministries such as:

- establishing a Standing Bible Translation Committee
- raising awareness to abuse of power by church leaders
- how confidentiality is used, misused and abused
- confessional teaching especially from the Canons of Dort
- the relationship between Biblical principles and political discipleship/advocacy
- pressing social justice issues both in Canada and the United States
- developing and funding a new teaching curriculum
- unresolved conflict in the CRCNA
