

The **Safe Church Committee** recognizes the importance (as stated in our Handbook under "Vision") to love, support and care for each other. It has been brought to the attention of the committee that during coffee fellowship time on Sundays, the behaviour of some our younger members in the church

basement is too intense for an indoor environment and on occasion, border-line unsafe. In addition, there have been reports of the Nursery/Little Lambs rooms being "messed up" and the toys being mistreated by children who are too old for them. For these reasons, the committee has recently established the role of "After-Church Hall Monitor". This volunteer will monitor the basement area during coffee fellowship time, to discourage undesirable behaviour and to encourage our younger members to join the rest of the congregation in the fellowship hall to participate in less intense activities and fellowship. Our Sunday School teachers have already volunteered to take turns in this new role. We are requesting the congregation's support of this new initiative. Parents, please be aware of where your children are during coffee fellowship time and encourage them to spend that time engaging with one another in "indoor friendly" and less physical activities.
