On this **Cadet Sunday** we give thanks to God for this ministry to boys aged seven to thirteen. The Calvinist Cadet Corps asks we pray a blessing over the recent Congress meeting held in Grand Rapids. He is now in Room #922 and continues to receive daily stroke rehabilitation. Pray for continual improvement.

After recently learning his lymphoma cancer has returned, **Pastor Vic V.** has begun five months of chemotherapy treatments. As we continually pray for treatment effectiveness, anyone wishing to send a note of encouragement to Pastor Vic and Nancy is invited to do so. We join **World Renew** in prayer and concern for the world's largest humanitarian crisis in **Yemen**. Around 22 million people need assistance and 8 million face famine-like conditions daily.
